INTRODUCTION

BIBLICAL LESSON

As you go through this special day, remember that Jesus suffered, bled and died so that we would be cleansed from our sins. Today we join in the sufferings of Christ for a while in honor of his sacrifice, because of the commandment of God to keep this day. Know that it took a tremendous sacrifice to bring about our holiness. This lesson explores Jesus' sacrifice for our sins.

He made atonement for our sins. Romans 5:6-21, Hebrews 9:1-14, 24-28

APPLICATION

God has cleansed us from our sins. Think of a person you have not forgiven, and use God's example of this day to wipe the slate clean.
